

# Creating a Developing Honor Society Display

An honor society display visually communicates information to the public. Whether it's a table or a cabinet, ensuring that your developing honor society provides a polished presentation is important for leaving visitors with a positive impression of your group. The following checklist will assist you in putting together an impressive display.

## Display Tables

### Items You'll Need:

- Things that symbolize the membership/developing honor society experience (honor cords, T-shirts, journals, etc.)
- Photos
- Tablecloth
- Cardboard boxes of varying levels to add height. Hide them under a tablecloth for a nice presentation.
- Handouts (fliers, brochures, pens, etc.)

## Display Cabinets

### Items You'll Need:

- High-quality photos of developing honor society members or developing honor society events.
- Items that symbolize the membership/developing honor society experience (honor cords, T-shirts, journals, etc.)
- Staples, tape, or pushpins

## When building your display:

- Consider your audience (students, professionals, etc.). Build a table that would be most appealing to that group.
- Make it interactive. Provide free gifts or have a video playing on a tablet or laptop.
- Make it informational. Provide fliers or brochures about the developing honor society with contact information.
- Include conversation pieces, such as a photo book or other meaningful memorabilia.
- Show off your achievements. If your developing honor society has received recognition or awards, include those to convey excellence.
- Keep it neat. Too many items in a display can be distracting.
